Thursday Double Chance
Terms and Conditions

1. The Thursday Double Chance tournament will run every Thursday from 2nd May 2024 at 7pm and is open to all customers.
2. Each entrant must register at the Poker Desk from 6.15pm prior to commencement of the tournament at 7pm, late registrations must be registered by 9.15pm.
3. All entrants must pay the entrance fee of £35 (£28 buy-in, £2 promotional fee and £5 registration) prior to the commencement of play.
4. The promotional fee contributes to the Cardroom Promotional Fund.
5. Prior to the commencement of the tournament 25,000 starting stack of chips will be placed on the table for each paid entrant.
6. Upon entry players will receive a receipt of payment slip which can be exchanged for a further 25,000 chips at no extra cost.
7. This second allocation of chips can be redeemed after the conclusion of the first hand of the tournament and must be redeemed before recommencement of play after the first tournament break (approximately 9:15pm).
8. Players who do not redeem their second allocation of chips before the specified time forfeit these chips.
9. Players who lose their complete 50,000 chips before the conclusion of the first break may re-enter for the complete entrance fee and follow the same procedure for redeeming both allocations of chips.
10. A starting stack of chips may be placed in a seat to accommodate late entrants (so all antes and blinds have been appropriately paid). An unsold seat will have such a stack removed at a time left to the discretion of the tournament director (usually at the end of the rebuy period).
11. Unlimited re-entries will be permitted for the specified late registration period of the tournament but will be relocated to another table if possible. A re-entry will need to join an existing alternate list and is not seated as a re-buy. They will be seated as close to the big blind as possible if being seated manually or seated randomly if such a system is in place (i.e., seating cards or a digital seating system). Registration fees will apply.
12. All MG Poker Tournaments are governed by the Tournament Rules displayed in the Poker Room and are available on request.
13. 10% of the field paid in prizes, to be determined by the Tournament Director.
14. Completed competition guarantees a £500 prize pool.
15. All prize money will be paid out to players in cash as per the pay-out structure available from the Poker Desk.
16. Tournament Director's decision is final.
17. Between 7th January and 1st November 2026, one £400 Irish Poker Tour Main Event ticket will be added from the cardroom promotional fund and awarded to the winners of the Wednesday Super Stack and Thursday Double Chance tournaments. The ticket is valid for the 2026 Irish Poker Tour Main Event. If the event is cancelled, the ticket will be converted to cardroom credit.

18. Entry constitutes acceptance by the entrant of these terms and conditions.
19. Any complaints or disputes should be brought to the immediate attention of Venue Management for resolution.
20. The Promoter reserves the right to cancel or amend the promotion at any time. If participants have already met the qualifying criteria for the promotion, they will be entitled to participate in the promotion on the terms entered, (subject to any expiry or other conditions contained in these terms) and entitled to any benefits associated with the promotion.
21. Employees of the Promoter, their agents, families, or household members are prohibited from participating in this promotion.
