



Alea Glasgow Weekly Poker Tournaments Terms and Conditions

Tuesday Jackpot Tournament

1. The Tuesday Jackpot tournament will run every Tuesday 24th February 2026 from at 7pm and is open to all customers.
2. Each entrant must register at the Poker Desk from 6:15pm prior to the commencement of the tournament at 7pm. Late registrations must be completed by 9:20pm.
3. All entrants must pay the entrance fee of £40 (£28 buy-in, £5 jackpot, £5 registration fee and £2 promotional contribution) prior to the commencement of play.
4. The promotional contribution goes to the Cardroom Promotional Fund, which is used for all promotions within the cardroom.
5. The jackpot fee contributes to the progressive jackpot, with 20% withheld as a reserve fund for the following week should the jackpot be won.
6. Prior to the commencement of the tournament, a 25,000 starting stack of chips will be placed on the table for each paid entrant.
7. A starting stack of chips may be placed in a seat to accommodate late entrants (so all antes and blinds have been appropriately paid). An unsold seat will have such a stack removed at a time left to the discretion of the Tournament Director (usually at the end of the rebuy period).
8. Unlimited re-entries will be permitted for the specified late registration period of the tournament but will be relocated to another table if possible. A re-entry will need to join an existing alternate list and is not seated as a re-buy. They will be seated as close to the big blind as possible if being seated manually, or seated randomly if such a system is in place (i.e. seating cards or a digital seating system). Registration fees will apply.
9. All MG Poker Tournaments are governed by the Tournament Rules displayed in the Poker Room and are available on request.
10. The Tournament Director's decision is final.
11. The completed competition guarantees a £1,000 prize pool.
12. 10% of the field will be paid in prizes, to be determined by the Tournament Director.
13. All prize money will be paid out to players in cash as per the pay-out structure available from the Poker Desk.
14. The winner (or winners in the event of a deal) will proceed to the Jackpot Selection, which will be carried out as follows:
 - a. The jackpot deck shall be obtained from the Cash Desk. All 52 cards will be spread face up in suited order and thereafter spread face down to verify that all cards are identical.



- b. The jackpot deck shall be shuffled by a Cardroom Supervisor in accordance with standard casino poker shuffling procedures and then spread face down for the winner to select four cards.
 - c. In the event of a deal, players may split the number of card selections between them, provided that each selected card remains clearly identifiable and separate for camera purposes.
 - d. All card selections must be made in a clear manner, whereby the selecting player shall slide the chosen card forward or backward while it remains face down. The Cardroom Supervisor shall then align the selected cards in a single row. Only after all selections have been completed shall the Cardroom Supervisor reveal the selected cards one at a time.
 - e. The Ace of Spades must be revealed within the selected cards for the Jackpot to be won.
 - f. From the effective date of this promotion until 1 November 2026, if the Four of Clubs is revealed within the selected cards, the tournament winner shall be awarded an Irish Poker Tour (IPT) Main Event ticket, regardless of whether the Ace of Spades is revealed.
 - g. Eligibility to receive the Irish Poker Tour Main Event ticket is conditional upon the winner being a registered member of the casino at the time of award.
 - h. Irish Poker Tour Main Event tickets awarded under this promotion are transferable.
 - i. Once all selected cards have been revealed, the remaining cards shall be turned face up and displayed to confirm that only one Ace of Spades is present in the deck.
 - j. If the Ace of Spades is revealed within the selected cards, a full deck and camera review shall be conducted to confirm that the Jackpot selection procedure has been correctly followed.
 - k. If the Ace of Spades is not revealed within the selected cards, the jackpot will not be won and will roll over to the following week.
15. Entry constitutes acceptance by the entrant of these terms and conditions.
16. Any complaints or disputes should be brought to the immediate attention of Venue Management for resolution.
17. The Promoter reserves the right to cancel or amend the promotion at any time. If participants have already met the qualifying criteria for the promotion, they will be entitled to participate in the promotion on the terms entered (subject to any expiry or other conditions contained in these terms) and entitled to any benefits associated with the promotion.
18. Employees of the Promoter, their agents, families, or household members are prohibited from participating in this promotion.
19. Disregard or failure to meet any of these terms may result in management cancelling prizes.
