21+3 DYNAMIC JACKPOT GAME

The rules for Blackjack 21+3 Dynamic Jackpot Game, Local and linked at this casino (set out below) are our commitment to the players in ensuring that the gambling we offer is 'Fair and Open'. Any complaints or disputes should be brought to the immediate attention of Venue Management for resolution.

JACKPOT WAGER

- To make this wager a player must also make a standard blackjack wager.
- This wager is that the player's first two cards combined with the Dealer's first card forms a Three Card Poker hand of a straight or better.
- Once bets are locked in, 1-3 of the fixed pay hands will be randomly selected and dynamically multiply up to 10x.
- If the player's first two cards combined with the Dealer's first card forms a Three Card Poker hand of a straight or better, they will be paid the amounts below for their stake.

HAND	£5 Local
Three Aces, Kings or Queens Suited (Suited)	100% of the Jackpot
Three of a Kind (Suited)	£500 to £5,000
Straight Flush	£100 to £1,000
Three of a Kind (Off Suit)	£50 to £500
Straight	£10 to £100

HAND	£10 Local
Three Aces, Kings or Queens Suited (Suited)	100% of the Jackpot
Three of a Kind (Suited)	£1,000 to £10,000
Straight Flush	£200 to £2,000
Three of a Kind (Off Suit)	£100 to £1,000
Straight	£20 to £200

HAND	£25 Link
Three Aces (Suited)	100% of the Jackpot
Three of a Kind (Suited)	£3,000 to £30,000
Straight Flush	£500 to £5,000
Three of a Kind (Off Suit)	£300 to £3,000
Straight	£50 to £500

- If the Player's hand does not hit one of the above rankings, the Jackpot wager will lose.
- Only the highest hand formed from each player's ranking hand with the Dealer's first card will be paid out.
- In the event of a misdeal all wagers are void.
- The Linked Jackpot is between all London Casinos owned by Metropolitan Gaming, with all bets placed contributing to the linked Jackpot meter.



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A PLAYER'S GUIDE TO THE HOUSE EDGE

The House Edge is a measure of how much the House expects to win, expressed as a percentage of the player's wager. For example, in a wager with a House Edge of five percent the player will lose on average over time, £5 for every £100 wagered. House Edges vary by region, casino, and game. In some games, player betting or skills decisions can affect the Edge, but it is important to keep in mind that the House always has some advantage against the typical player.
