



3 Card Poker & Heads Up Hold'em Linked and Local Jackpot Game

The rules for the 3 Card Poker & Head's Up Hold'em Tri-CityLink Jackpot at this casino (as set out below) are our commitment to players in ensuring that the gambling we offer is 'Fair and Open'. Any complaints or disputes should be brought to the immediate attention of Venue Management for resolution.

JACKPOT WAGER

- To make this wager, a player must also make a pair plus and/or an ante wager.
- The wager must be placed on the betting sensor prior to all wagers being locked into play by the dealer.
- Once the dealer has 'locked out' the betting sensors, no more bets on these wagers can be accepted.
- Jackpot wagers with a ranking hand, will be paid according to the pay table.
- Each coloured sensor will require a fixed stake to play, have its own independent Jackpot hand and own pay table. (Please see table displays or ask a team member for information)
- If the player's hand is not one of the winning hands from the pay table, the Jackpot wager will lose.
- In the event of a misdeal all wagers are void.
- If the player folds their hand this automatically results in the jackpot wager losing, even in the event the folded hand would have resulted in a winning event
- In the event of a hand shuffle only game, the Jackpot(s) wager will not be available for play.
- All 3 Card Poker (TCP) and Heads up Hold'em (HUH) tables with the Jackpot in play within this casino are either contributing to a Linked Jackpot or local Jackpots total.
- All payouts apart from the jackpot will require a 3-card hand to qualify. For a Mini Royal this will require the hand to consist of Ace, King and Queen of specific suits to qualify
- For TCP qualifying hands this will consist of the three cards dealt to the player
- For HUH qualifying hands this will consist of the two cards dealt with to the player and the first community card



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LINKED JACKPOT PAYTABLES

Tri-City Link £5 STAKE

5-Card Royal Flush 100% of the Jackpot

TCP = Any combination of the 3 cards dealt to player and 3 cards dealt to the dealer that create a 5-card royal flush

HUH = Any combination of the 2 players card and the first 4 community card to create a 5-card royal flush (Last community card not included)

Mini Royal (Diamonds)	£3750 to £37500
Mini Royal	£1000 to £10000
Straight Flush	£200 to £2000
Three of a Kind	£100 to £1000

LOCAL JACKPOT PAYTABLES

TCP and HUH £1 STAKE

Mini Royal (Diamonds)	100% of the Jackpot
Mini Royal (Other)	£200 to £2000
Straight Flush	£20 to £200
Three of a Kind	£10 to £100
Straight	£2 to £20



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A PLAYER'S GUIDE TO THE HOUSE EDGE

The house Edge is a measure of how much the house expects to win, expressed as a percentage of the player's wager. For example, in a wager with the house edge of 5% the player will lose £5 for every £100 wagered. House edge varies by region, casino and game. In some games, player betting or skills decisions can affect the edge but it is important to keep in mind that the house always has some advantage against the typical player.
